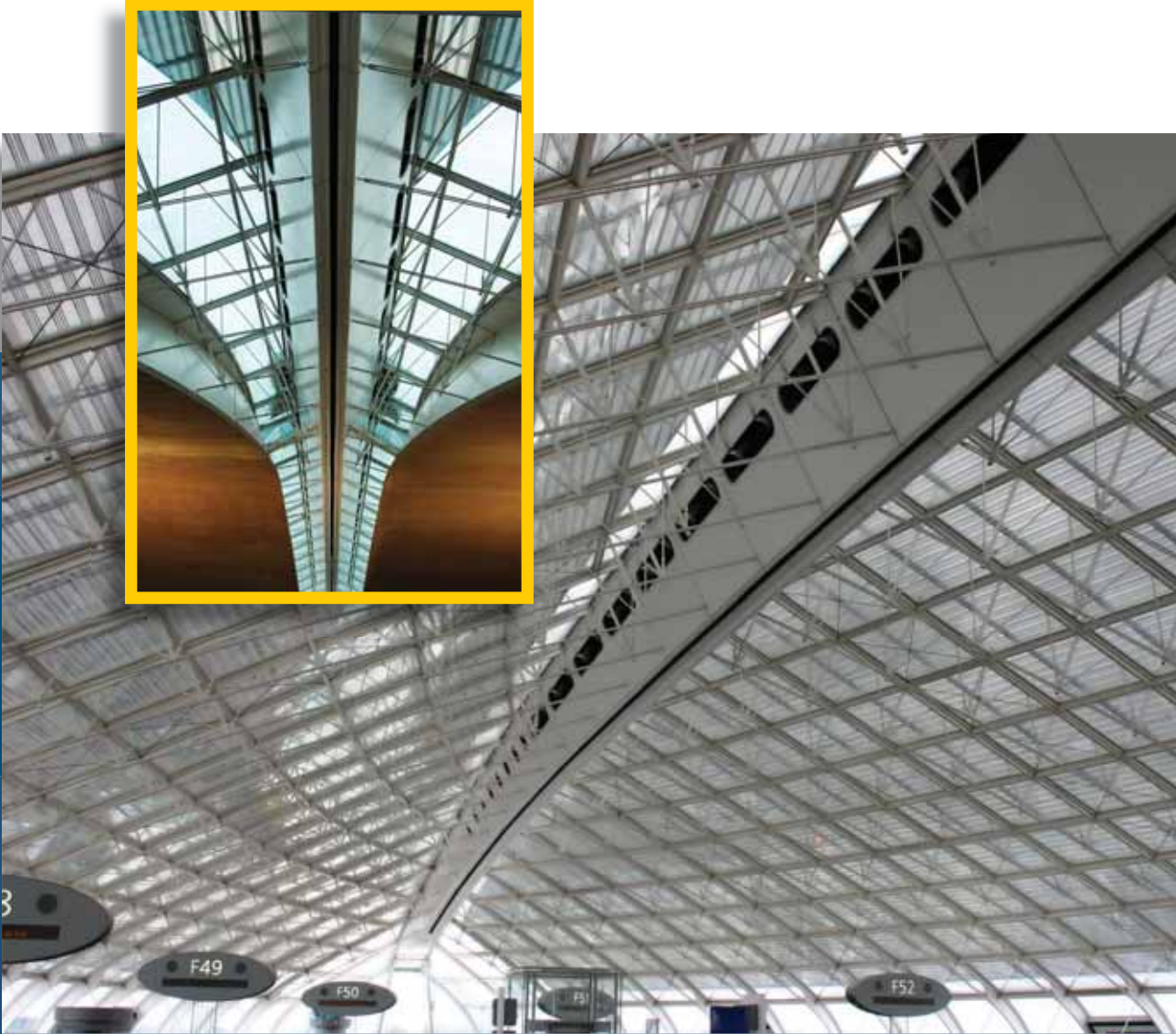

The roof at an airport in Paris is made of squares, too. But these squares are different. They are made of strong glass.



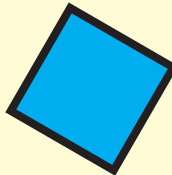
The design of this airport in Costa Rica is fun. It has circles inside the squares.
