## LET'S EXPLORE MATH

The **chart** below shows how much cat litter is used each day. In 1 day, 5 cats use 3 pounds of litter.

**Pounds of Litter Used Daily**

| Number of Cats | Litter Used |
|----------------|-------------|
| 5              | 3 pounds    |
| 10             | 5 pounds    |
| 15             | 8 pounds    |
| 20             | 10 pounds   |
| 25             | 13 pounds   |
